WHEREAS, Mr. Christopher Krupar has served the people of Albuquerque, as the Information Systems Manager for the Albuquerque Housing Authority (AHA) from May 2005 to November 14, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Chris has successfully facilitated the AHA modernizing its computer systems during that ten year period and successfully lead AHA to move forward in implementing new information technology systems: to convert its internal office telephone system from old and no longer adequate system of voice mail to new, a state of art, Voice Over Internet Protocol (VOIP) system; to then build a new, stand alone office email system, as well as multiple internal and external websites and networks for AHA to use, (replacing and surpassing the City of Albuquerque government websites and city employee email systems); and facilitating AHA converting to online services.

WHEREAS, Chris has served this Board honorably since it was founded in July 2011, attending nearly every Regular and Special meeting of the Board for more than three years, to make sure the audio and visual equipment worked correctly, and posting Board information online; and

WHEREAS, he has provided strong and thoughtful leadership to propose, adopt and implement new, advanced technologies and tools for reform at AHA, to help lead the agency from a troubled past toward and exciting and more productive future, and his technical skill was critical in helping AHA function successfully and thrive in recent years after becoming a separate Public Body Corporate and Politic; and

WHEREAS, Chris has placed the interests of the common good of the community, ahead of his own personal comfort, by answering the call to public service, by agreeing to work at a very demanding job that often had him reporting to work at the office in the hours before everyone else, as well as working on nights, weekends and holidays, to keep the network fully operational and secure at all times;

WHEREAS, Chris Krupar's term of employment at AHA concluded on November 14, 2014, when he left for a promotion to an exciting new information technology job in public service at a different local government agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AHA BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS, the governing body of the AHA that:
