BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO. 2018-04

ADOPTION OF THE FY2019 ADMISSIONS AND CONTINUED OCCUPANCY POLICY

WHEREAS, the Annual Contributions Contract (ACC) between the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and Albuquerque Housing Authority (AHA) requires, and federal regulations also require, the AHA to update the Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (ACOP) for the Public Housing Program as needed;

WHEREAS, the FY2019 ACOP has been revised and updated and the AHA is desirous of adopting the revised and updated policies, and;

WHEREAS, the proposed FY2019 ACOP was posted online in 2018 for public review and a public notice was posted in the AHA office lobby and in other locations, and printed in the Albuquerque Journal to actively seek public comment on the plan, and multiple public meetings, plus a public hearing were held to gather public input, and the comments received were seriously considered and changes were made by AHA staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AHA BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS, the governing body of the AHA that:

The Board finds that AHA needs to adopt an updated Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (ACOP) this year. A copy of the FY2019 ACOP is attached as Exhibit A. The FY2019 ACOP is hereby adopted for the use by the Albuquerque Housing Authority pursuant to the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to include the Quality Housing and Work Responsibility Act (QHWRA) of 1998 as amended and is effective July 1, 2018.
