## BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO. 2014-26

### SOCIAL SECURITY COVERAGE FOR THE ALBUQUERQUE HOUSING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, under the provisions of NMSA 1978, Section 10-14-1 et. seq. (1995) as amended, and 42 United States Code (USC) 418, as amended, governmental entities of this State may enter into Agreements with the Public Employees Retirement Association of New Mexico, the agency of the State of New Mexico designated by the Governor to administer the Social Security Coverage Act, and to secure the benefits of Federal Old-Age, Survivors, Disability and Health Insurance (Social Security coverage or Health Insurance only), as outlined in said laws; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board, the governing body of the Albuquerque Housing Authority (AHA), that the extension of this Old-Age, Survivors, Disability and Health Insurance System will be of benefit not only to the employees of the Albuquerque Housing Authority itself by attracting to it and enabling it to retain the best of personnel and thus increase the efficiency of its operation; and it is deemed and is hereby declared that the payment by the Albuquerque Housing Authority of its portion of the cost of said system is a payment for purposes for which it was created; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the governing body of the Albuquerque Housing Authority to authorize the making of any and all necessary Agreements in order to secure the benefits of said acts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AHA BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS, the governing body of the AHA that:

1. That the Board, acting for and on behalf of the Albuquerque Housing Authority, shall enter into all necessary Agreements with the Social Security Administrator for the State of New Mexico for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the above-mentioned acts.
2. That a majority choice vote referendum will be held on Wednesday, March 4, 2015 on the question of whether or not Albuquerque Housing Authority employees who belong to the Public Employees Retirement Association (PERA) of New Mexico retirement plan also want to secure the benefits of Federal Old-Age, Survivors, Disability and Health Insurance (OASDI).
3. That Linda Bridge, Executive Director, is hereby appointed as Agent of the Albuquerque Housing Authority to execute all necessary Agreements and instruments for and in behalf of said governing body and the Albuquerque Housing Authority.
4. That a sufficient sum of money be allocated from available funds for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the above-mentioned acts.


