## BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO. 2017-05

## AMENDMENT TO THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017, BEGINNING JULY 1, 2016 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2017

**WHEREAS**, the Albuquerque Housing Authority (AHA), a New Mexico Public Body Corporate and Politic, has passed and adopted Resolution 2016-08 (Operating Budget for FY2017), on June 22, 2016, to appropriate funding for the continued operation of AHA; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Housing Law of New Mexico (§3-45-1 NMSA 1978) authorizes the AHA Board to adopt an annual budget to appropriate funding for the continued operation of the AHA; and

WHEREAS, the budget amendment findings are administrative only to allocate budget where it is being expensed which allows the financials to be better represented to the Board; and

WHEREAS, the AHA Board finds that it is in the long term best interest of AHA to approve adoption of this Budget Amendment (a copy of the Financial Year 2017 Budget Amendment is attached as Exhibit A) to better represent the allocated funding for the operation of AHA programs; and

WHEREAS, the budget amendments apply to all AHA programs (e.g. Public Housing, Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers, and Central Office Cost Center (COCC)) for the period of Fiscal Year 2017, that begins on July 1, 2016 and ends on June 30, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AHA BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS, the Governing Body of AHA, that the proposed Budget Amendment for Financial Year 2017 is a hereby approved.
