**ADOPTION OF THE 2018 REVISED ACCOUNTING POLICY FOR AHA**

**WHEREAS**, as a municipal Public Housing Authority (PHA) and a public body corporate and politic formed by the City of Albuquerque in the State of New Mexico, the Albuquerque Housing Authority (AHA) is obligated as a public employer to ensure that that its assets are safeguarded, that its financial statements are in conformity with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP), and that its finances are managed with responsible stewardship; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board recognizes the importance of adopting revised and updated policies and procedures to ensure that current laws and regulations are followed, that public resources are used efficiently and effectively, and that PHA objectives are achieved; and

**WHEREAS**, the AHA Board of Housing Commissioners seeks to adopt revisions to the formal written Accounting Policy for the Albuquerque Housing Authority;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AHA BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS**, the governing body of the AHA, that the revised Accounting Policy is approved. A copy of the revised policy is attached as Exhibit A.
