WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Housing Authority (“AHA”) Board of Housing Commissioners (“Board”) met in regular session on at the AHA office on September 21, 2016 at 12:00 Noon; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Rebecca Chavez was appointed by Mayor Richard J. Berry on March 28, 2011 (Executive Communication 11-440) to serve the people of the City of Albuquerque, New Mexico, by serving as an unpaid volunteer member of the newly formed AHA Board; and

WHEREAS, Housing Commissioner Rebecca Chavez has placed the interests of the common good of the community of Albuquerque ahead of her own personal interests, by volunteering to spend her own limited free time to prepare for and attend Housing Authority Board meetings from 2011 to 2016, to speak and vote as the representative of AHA Public Housing and Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher tenants, while working full time, raising a child, and graduating from the AHA Family Self Sufficiency (FSS) Program and earning a degree from the University of New Mexico (UNM); and

WHEREAS, Ms. Rebecca Chavez’s initial term of public office as Resident Commissioner expired on December 1, 2013, and she then volunteered to do even more work by attending Board meetings until her successor was recruited and sworn into office, which has finally occurred in September 2016; and


