Section 3 Income Limits

All residents (of any income level) of public housing developments of the Albuquerque Housing Authority (AHA) qualify as Section 3 residents. Additionally, individuals residing in the Albuquerque Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) of Bernalillo, Sandoval, Torrance and Valencia Counties, who are members of a household that meets the household income limits (Area Median Income - AMI) set forth below, can also qualify for Section 3 resident status.
