WHEREAS, Ms. Roxanne Rivera-Weist was appointed by Mayor Richard J. Berry in 2011 in Executive Communication 2011-379 to serve the people of the City of Albuquerque, New Mexico, by sharing her professional expertise, by serving as an early pioneer member of the AHA Board; and as a faithful & trustworthy community leader, she earned re-appointment to serve a 2nd term starting in 2017;

WHEREAS, Commissioner Roxanne Rivera-Wiest utilized her education and experience to wisely govern AHA and provide steady leadership that kept AHA on a path to success for a decade, and;
