**ADOPTION OF THE REVISED FY2023 SECTION 8 HCV ADMINISTRATIVE PLAN FOR AHA**

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Contributions Contract (ACC) between the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and Albuquerque Housing Authority (AHA) requires, and federal regulations also require, the AHA to review and update the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Administrative Plan as needed;

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Administrative Plan was approved on April 20, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, AHA revised the FY2023 Administrative Plan policy on the use of Administrative Fee Reserves in accordance with HUD PIH Notice 2022-18 on July 27, 2022;

**WHEREAS**, AHA is revising the FY2023 Administrative Plan policy on the cap on number of Project Based Voucher units per Project to be consistent with HUD PIH Notice 2017-21.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AHA BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS**, the governing body of the AHA that:

AHA needs to adopt an updated Administrative Plan every year to comply with HUD regulations. The Revised FY2023 Administrative Plan is hereby adopted for the use by the Albuquerque Housing Authority pursuant to the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to include the Quality Housing and Work Responsibility Act (QHWRA) of 1998 as amended and is effective November 16, 2022.
