ADOPTION OF THE AHA CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY

WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Housing Authority (AHA) is the Co-Grantee of the 2023 HUD Choice Neighborhoods Planning Grant and is required to sign a grant agreement with the City of Albuquerque (Lead Grantee) and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD);

WHEREAS, HUD requires the Lead Grantee and Co-Grantee to develop and maintain written standards/codes of conduct covering conflicts of interest and governing the actions of its employees engaged in the selection, award, and administration of contracts before entering into the grant agreement;

WHEREAS, the current AHA Conflict of Interest Policy does not include the “Conducting Business in Accordance with Ethical Standards/Code of Conduct” requirement found in Sections IV.G and VI.B of the 2023 Choice Neighborhoods Planning Grant Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AHA BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS, the governing body of the AHA that:

AHA adopts an updated 2023 Conflict of Interest Policy to comply with HUD regulations for the 2023 Choice Neighborhoods Planning Grant Award. A copy of the 2023 AHA Conflict of Interest Policy is attached as Exhibit A. The Albuquerque Housing Authority hereby adopts the 2023 AHA Conflict of Interest Policy.
